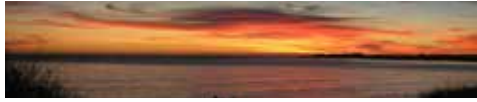


Flying Away at the Air Zoo!

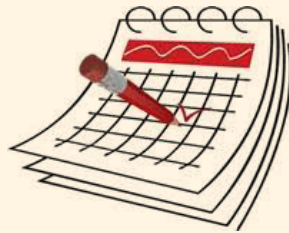

Our Rehab Success Story

During the month of July, Karen Wagner suffered a serious fall with a back injury leaving her weaker and needing assistance with her care. Mrs. Wagner shared with us how our services had been highly recommended by family and friends. She also told us how initially she was quite frightened from poor experiences with other facilities many years past; therefore it was with great skepticism and trepidation that Karen agreed to come to ACMCC and allow us to help.



Today, we are very proud of Karen. With just over 10 days work with our physical and occupational therapists, she is ready to return home safely. Karen will be leaving with a renewed faith in skilled nursing facilities such as ACMCC and with herself. Karen's message to those reading is a powerful one.

"You might think you can just go home from the hospital. You might think you can do it all by yourself. But when you get home, you don't realize how weak you are and how much help you need and you may even be too proud to ask. There are a lot of good people out there that want to help you. Don't be afraid of a challenge! These people are trained and know what they are doing. In the long run it's going to be so much better. Thank God for places like this."
