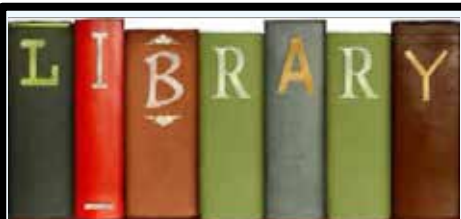
Generations Adult Day Care
